SCHOOL OF YOUR CHOICE

CURRICULUM PRIMARY (CLASSES I - V)

To help students explore different realms of knowledge and imagination, at the primary level, subjects dealt with are English (taking into account multilingualism as a learning resource), Hindi (as a second language), Mathematics (focusing on reasoning and conceptual development), Environmental Studies (helping to learn about the environment), Science (to develop a sense of practical thinking), Social Studies, Computer Studies and Arts Education. Thus providing scope for creativeness, appreciation and working together by learning these subjects.

CURRICULUM JUNIORS (CLASSES VI – VIII)

At this level subjects covered are English, Hindi, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology (under Science) History, Civics and Geography (under Social Studies), Computer Studies/Art Education and One Optional Subject, helping students understand key concepts, and develop soft skills and a sense of learning through experimentation and observation through activities.

Note: Subjects, Physics, Chemistry and Biology are taught as a combined subject under SCIENCE and subjects History, Civics and Geography under SOCIAL STUDIES in CBSE affiliated school.

CURRICULUM PRE PRIMARY (NUR - KG)

The preschool program for Raj Kumar Academy & Raj Kumar Inter College is designed to cater for children between 3 to 5 years of age, teaching them about life skills, basic etiquette, learning through hands-on experience and focusing on holistic development thus helping them feel competent and confident.

ACADEMIC ASSESSMENTS (EXAMINATIONS / TESTS)

Examinations are conducted twice a year:

- 1. Half-Yearly
- 2. Annual

In order to evaluate the performance of a child regular class tests along with monthly tests are conducted around the year.

The minimum passing percentage is 40%.

Note: Promotion is granted based on marks obtained in the Half Yearly and Final Examinations as well as the marks secured in the tests.

BOARD EXAMINATIONS

Board examinations are conducted as per the guidelines issued by the respective affiliated school boards. Also to give them enough practice school conducts its internal Comparative & Pre-board examinations.



Students will only be permitted to enter the school campus in a neat and clean school uniform. Untidy and improperly dressed children will not be allowed to attend the classes.

ADMISSION PROCESS

Parents seeking admission for their children are required to fill out the registration form available at the school office upon payment of the prescribed fee. A Birth Certificate/Transfer Certificate from the previous institution is a must for admission and it should be submitted at the time of admission. Admission will not be granted without a Birth Certificate issued from Nagar Nigam and a Transfer Certificate issued by the previous school of learning. All admission to classes (IX) & (XI) will be granted on the approval of the school management. No admission is granted in classes (X) & (XII). The minimum age for the students seeking admission is three (3) years for the Playgroup section, four (4) years for Nursery, five (5) years for K.G. and so on. (No exemptions are made).

SCHOOL FEE

Parents are advised to seek a fee schedule at the time of admission or the start of the new session. The Fee can be deposited ONLINE or at the school cash counter. The parents are requested to deposit their fees on any date before the 10th of every month. In case of failure to deposit the fee within the stipulated dates, a late fee will be charged. If your ward's 3-month fee is not paid by the 10th of the third month, his/her name shall be cut off from the register. A Re-Admission fee shall be levied to continue his/her name.

Note:

- Fee once deposited will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- The Fee charged as per schedule can be changed due to unforeseen circumstances for which parents will be informed separately.
- The School does not provide any fee concession to its students. Concessions may be granted to exceptionally meritorious students and the school's decision would be final in this respect.

- (a) Students are expected to report to school in neat and proper uniforms and well-groomed.
 - 1. Girls maintaining long hair should keep them neatly oiled and tied back in two braids with black ribbon bands and pins; those with short hair must wear black Alice bands.
 - 2. Boys must maintain short hair cuts not more than preferably crew cuts, 1½ inches being the maximum permissible length.
- (b) Students must report to school every day at least five minutes before the prescribed school time. Late arrivals are not allowed.
- (c) Any instance of indiscipline shall be severely dealt with and no correspondence or discussion shall be entertained in this respect.
- (d) Students are not allowed to leave the school campus during school hours. The Principal's permission should be sought in case of emergency.
- (e) Diaries, test copies and report cards are to be duly signed by the parents and returned promptly.
- (f) All complaints regarding academics must be directed to the Principal. Any other complaints shall be dealt with by the school office.
- (g) No student is allowed to bring cash or valuables to the school. The school shall not be held responsible for any losses of such items.
- (h) The promotion of a student will depend on his/her general progress with a major emphasis on academic performance and discipline. Application and discussions in this respect are not entertained.
- (I) The students are not allowed to come by 2- wheeler motor vehicle if they are not eligible as per the Govt. norms. Those coming by 2-wheeler must-wear helmets, failing which a heavy penalty will be levied.
- (j) The decision of the Principal would be final in all respects and there should be no interference, either from within or from outside in any case.
- (k) Students causing damage to any school property shall be penalized or fined for the same.
- (I) In case of indiscipline and irregularity the School has the right to suspend or rusticate a student. No correspondence or discussion shall be entertained in such matters.
- (m) A student's attendance must not be less than 80% to make him/her eligible to sit in the Annual Examination of the class he/she is in, of that academic year, as well as promotion to the next level.
 - 1. Scheduled and unscheduled leaves shall be granted only when applied for, as per the procedure laid out by the school.
 - 2. Leave shall not be granted just a week before or during the exams.
 - 3. The name of a student who remains absent for three continuous days without leave application shall be truck off the rolls. He/She will have to seek re-admission only after paying re-admission charges, late penalty and any other dues.
 - 4. Students must report to school on the scheduled date of re-opening.
- (n) The school provides various sports activities on campus. Though full care is taken to ensure the well-being and safety of all students, in case of any physical injury or fatal injury, the school will not be responsible in any manner.
